



## ACCEPTABLE PROOFS OF ADDRESS FOR A NEW LIBRARY CARD

When you apply for a Field Library card, we need to determine that you reside or work within our service area. We require **two forms of proof of your name and address**.

*Acceptable proofs of address include:*

- Valid driver's license
- Vehicle registration
- Pre-printed checks
- Any U.S. Mail with your name and street address
- Bills with your name and street address

We can accept only addresses in our local service area. **We cannot accept a PO Box as a local address.**

We realize that providing two proofs of address may be difficult for young adults (in Grades 7 and up). If a patron in this age group applies for a library card in the presence of a parent or guardian, the adult's identification may be counted as one of the required proofs. **A student ID is also acceptable as one form.** One other proof of the young person's identity and address is still required. Examples of acceptable proof include:

- Student report card
- U.S. Mail delivered to the student at the home address
